

# Silicone Doll Care Instructions

Congratulations Mommy or Daddy! You've got your hands on one of the most life-like baby dolls ever created! It's time to learn about them to make sure you take great care of your sweetie!

Hand painted silicone dolls such as your new baby are extremely fragile works of art. They have many layers of intricate details that can be damaged if these instructions are not carefully followed. We are not responsible for any damages or repairs on your baby doll so please make sure you read this entirely. Take care of your baby very much as you would an actual infant.

Keep your baby away from any dangerous surfaces as silicone can be easily ruptured or broken. Silicone babies are not to be handled by children as they can be too rough and end up causing tears and damage to the paint of the doll. Adult supervision is always recommended to ensure the proper care of your newborn baby doll. Make sure baby is never pulled by the limbs but held with enough support for her weight. If peeling occurs, (which can happen even with high end silicone dolls) please do not peel. You can purchase Silpoxy to paste the skin down and follow directions according to product.

Although silicone dolls can be bathed please follow the bathing instructions carefully to ensure that your silicone paint lasts as long as possible. Silicone is very sticky and glossy by nature so feel free to powder your silicone as often as you'd like. You can use the provided powder or any powder of your choice as long as it is TALC-FREE.

## Bath Instructions:

Your baby doll is able to be bathed but please only do so when necessary to ensure the best upkeep of your doll.

1. Fill up a tub or sink with lukewarm water and pour a little bit of baby wash to create a soapy bath. Hold your baby as you introduce her in the bath and carefully run the soapy water on her. Lightly wash your doll with your hands and never scrub.
2. Rinse the soapy water with clean water and you're ready to dry.
3. PAT Dry your baby with a microfiber towel - never scrub (little fibers will likely stick to your doll so try to find a towel with strong micro fibers that don't shed too much)
4. Once your doll is fully dry, powder your baby freely. Use the provided powder or any powder of your choice as long as it is TALC FREE.

Hair Care: If hair gets wet during bath time, pat dry as much as you can and apply leave in conditioner while covering the babies face with a towel. Once conditioner is applied, use a soft bristle brush to style your baby's hair.

Baby Cologne: only apply cologne on baby's clothes. Never on her skin, as it could damage her paint.

DON'T : use lotions, wipes, alcohol based colognes or any other substance on your baby's skin, silicone is very fragile and any foreign substance can cause deterioration of the skin and paint.

DO: LOVE your baby and snuggle her often, make sure she is well taken care of and has a comfortable place to sleep.
